

Barton Road CV19

At all times members will comply with the governments social distancing measures. If you are feeling unwell or have any Corvid 19 symptoms, please do not attend the range however mild the symptoms may be.

At all distances only one person shooting from each firing point.

Only one person on each target frame.

A maximum of 19 members to be on the range at any one time.

There will be no guest or non-shooters permitted on the range complex.

If firearms or other equipment is shared, they are to be sanitised after each use by the holder of the firearm/equipment.

The shoot is to be booked in advance on a first come first served basis, the Secretary's decision on booking allocations if final. When applying for a slot on the shoot you are committing yourself to a full days shooting, shooting just one distance is not permitted.

Each of the 19 shooters will be given a number and must provide with their application the details of the firearms they propose to shoot. The RCO's will be number 9 and number 18.

The detail for each distance shot will be as follows: -

09:00 HME testing if required.

09:30 Members 1 to 5 will man the target frames with member 6 as butts officer and members 7 and 8 as sentries. Members 10 to 14 will be on the 800yds firing points with the RCO member 9. Members 15 to 19 will be standing 5m behind the members 15 to 19. Members 10 to 14 will shoot for 30 minutes.

10:00 Members 15 to 19 will man the firing points with members 10 to 14 standing 5m behind members 15 to 19. Members 15 to 19 shoot for 30 minutes.

10:30 Members 1 to 9 move to the firing points and members 10 to 19 move to the butts.

11:00 Members 11 to 15 will man the target frames, member 16 will be butts officer and members 10 and 17 will be sentries. Members 5 to 9 will man the 800yds firing points with RCO 18. Members 1 to 4 will be standing 5m behind members 5 to 9. Members 5 to 9 will shoot for 30 minutes.

11:30 Members 1 to 4 will man the firing points with members 5 to 9 standing 5m behind members 1 to 4. Members 1 to 4 will shoot for 30 minutes.

12:00 First distance complete move to next distance.

12:30 Members 1 to 5 will man the target frames with member 6 as butts officer and members 7 and 8 as sentries. Members 10 to 14 will be on the 1000yds firing points with the RCO member 9. Members 15 to 19 will be standing 5m behind the members 15 to 19. Members 10 to 14 will shoot for 30 minutes.

The cycle of changes continues as above until 15:30.

Range will close at 16:30.

Members must arrive by 08:30 and will sign in using their own pen and will bring the correct range fee of £15.00 in an envelope with their name on. Social distancing to be maintained at all times.
